

Communications Meetings

PREAMBLE

Communications Meetings are attended by Residents' Council Presidents, select members of the RLMT, senior Housing and Ancillary Services administration, and other professional staff as required. This is a key opportunity to interact with one another in order to obtain feedback on a variety of issues and to consider new ideas.

Council Presidents represent the voice of their respective residence community. Presidents are encouraged to bring topics of concern from Council or from the Residence community, as they are the principal advocates for these parties. Communications Meetings are an important forum for such discussions.

Meetings are held once per month. Discussions encompass different aspects of Residence Life including, but not limited to, policy changes and Council constitutions. The meetings can be used to standardize practices from residence to residence, but are also used to see how things are run differently between residences.

POLICY

Communications Meetings are held one per month.

PROCEDURE

Council Presidents also attend monthly meetings with the Programming Coordinator. These meetings are designated for Council development and general programming queries. For guidance on whether an item of discussion is more appropriate for a Communications Meeting or a President's Meeting, contact the Programming Coordinator or the Residence Manager.
